<u>Purpose</u>: This conference will continue a long tradition of informal exchange of ideas and provocative insights into the dynamics of nonlinear systems across disciplines of knowledge seeking to further advance the agenda of productive research into complex processes and their impact on policy and practice. The conference provides an opportunity to (re)connect with friends and colleagues and do further networking, stay up to date about what goes on in the field and explore new possibilities for applying the ideas of complexity and nonlinear dynamics in research and policy making.

<u>Location</u>: Mercy College was originally founded by the Sisters of Mercy in 1950 and it became a (nonreligious) four-year college in 1961. It is located in the lovely Hudson Valley about twenty miles north of New York City close to the Tappan Zee Bridge. The college offers academic excellence as well as river views and is thus a very suitable site for this conference. Our meeting space will be Room 32 in Mercy Hall.
